### **Minutes of monthly meeting held at the Village Hall, Rosemarket on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2005**

**Apologies :** Cllrs David Wildman, June Crook.

**Present :** Cllr's David Barrah (Chairman), Tony Young (Vice-chairman, Rhys Jones, Barbara Summons M.B.E. ,Alan Taylor, Peter Horton (Clerk).

#### **Minutes of the September monthly meeting**

These were accepted as written (proposer C'lrSummons, seconder C'lr Tony Young).

#### **Matters arising**

**No Entry signs, Sardis.** Members decided to take no further action in respect of the signs.

**Back Lane.** Members were informed that the work required related to cutting back the hedges overhanging the lane, Members mentioned that P.C.C. had always accepted responsibility for this work, but that it had not been done for some time. Clerk to mention to David Wildman.

**Litter Pick.** Members agreed to organise a litter picking session for early November, Clerk to ask David Wildman to arrange for P.C.C. to provide a skip outside Mrs Stewards house on the corner, to be used for this purpose.

**Beacon gates.** Members agreed to purchase a new gate for the beacon, along with a chain and two locks (proposer C'lr Rhys Jones, seconder C'lr Barbara Summons). Clerk to research cost of metal signs to fix to the gates on the Beacon forbidding horse-riding.

**Conveniences. Village hall.** Clerk to forward to the Rosemarket Village hall Committee a copy of the letter received from P.C.C. passing responsibility for the WCs to the community council. The letter to also confirm that said responsibility is agreed as being transferred to the village hall committee.

#### **Discussion of support for Radio Pembrokeshire campaign to oppose cuts to fire cover in Pembrokeshire**

Members decided to drop this matter, as the matter had originally been placed on the agenda by Colin Rogers, and nobody knew exactly what was up for discussion.

#### **Discussion of provision of wreaths for remembrance day services**

Members agreed to supply two for the services, one for the village hall, and one for the church (proposer C'lr Alan Taylor, seconder C'lr Tony Young).

#### **Discussion of unauthorised access alongside The Huntsman**

Members were still unhappy about the access, and asked the Clerk to obtain a written statement of the situation from P.C.C

#### **Discussion of wall in Big House Lane**

Members wondered why the matter had not been resolved. Clerk to mention the matter to David Wildman, who was thought to have been looking into the matter.

#### **Discussion of parking problems outside Big House**

Members were concerned at ongoing problems. Clerk to ask the enforcement officer to investigate possible breaches of planning conditions.

#### **Discussion of Christmas tree provision in village**

Members voted to obtain a tree again this year. C'lr Alan Taylor and Tony Young to arrange this. Clerk to ask David Wildman if he would be willing to do the lighting (proposer C'lr Alan Taylor, seconder C'lr Barbara Summons).

Members were concerned about ongoing parking problems. Clerk to contact Community Police Officers, and ask them to look into the matter.
