#### **Any other business**

**Coffee evening.** Members were informed that £601 had been raised at the recent event in support of Help for Heroes and H.O.P.E.

**School playground.** Members were informed that a car was parked in the playground without tax, and with three wheels missing. C'lr David Wildman undertook to look into the possibility of getting action taken by P.C.C. to remove it.

**St. Leonard's Well.** C'lr Barbara Summons was concerned at the lack of maintenance on the well, and felt that something should be done to carry out needed maintenance, pipe replacement and vegetation removal. C'lr Tony Young knew someone that might be prepared to undertake the work, and offered to obtain a quotation for this. Matter to be placed on July agenda for discussion.

**Signage.** C'lr Barbara Summons had received complaints about an obscured sign at the church, covered by vegetation.

**9, Westaway Park.** C'lr Barbara Summons mentioned encroachment of the hedge at this property onto the Highway.

**Bus shelter.** C'lr David Wildman felt that the issue of ownership of the bus shelter at Sardis should be clarified. Matter to be placed on July agenda for discussion. Clerk undertook to have the matter placed on the next Burton Community Council agenda for discussion there. Separate agenda item to be tabled for clarification of Community boundaries.
