Matters Arising

~~Cllr Young~~ Cllr Alan Taylor advised that the grass cutting had been done – payment of £50.00 required.

Planning

11/0490/AG – Great Westfield Farm, Thurston Lane, Sardis – notification from PCC that proposed irrigation reservoir does not require approval and can proceed whilst sticking to work as detailed in the original application.

11/0576/PA – Melrose House, Rosemarket – no objections.

Accounts

It was agreed that the above accounts be paid in full.

Correspondence

PCC – War Memorials – letter advising that grants were available for war memorials. Noted.

Discussion re. Speeding in the Village

Cllr Wildman advised that statistics showed that there was no actual speeding through the village but ~~Cllr Young~~ Cllr Taylor was still concerned that the speed which vehicles were travelling was still too fast for the vicinity. Of Various suggestions were made, including an illuminated ‘Slow Down’ sign costing £300-400. Cllr Wildman advised that a Children Playing sign was on order which he would chase up. Cllr Poar advised that she would contact Jackie Prest to ask her opinion on installing rumble strips. Matter to be listed on November agenda.

Discussion of Vehicles in Old Play Ground/Safeguarding of Car Park for Community Use

Cllr Wildman advised members that the solicitor at PCC had stated that a sign would need to be erected advising owners that vehicles are permitted to be parked at owners risk but this can be withdrawn at any time by RCC. Also the car park should be closed for one day a year. Councillors agreed on 30th June each year. Cllr Wildman agreed to get a price for the sign required.

Discussion re Dial a Ride Scheme

Councillors were advised that both Burton and Neyland councils had agreed to contribute to keep the service going. Cllr Wildman to find out who money should be paid to.

Discussion of problems with vehicles parking on the Milking Bank

Cllr Summons advised that vehicles were still parking on the bank. There had been no response from PCC to the letter sent by the clerk.Cllr Summons also advised that there was overgrowth narrowing the path. Cllr Wildman advised her to contact PCC Contact Centre.

Discussion re Village Hall Insurance Grant Request

Currently RCC makes a donation towards the insurance for the hall. This year the insurance was just under £900 so it was agreed to donation towards the hall for £900. ~~Cllr Young~~ Cllr Taylor proposed and Cllr Jones seconded the proposal.
