Discussion re. Speeding in the Village

Cllr Taylor advised that he had spoken with Jackie Prest who was happy to have rumble strips installed. She also suggested carrying out a survey amongst residents which she would arrange and collate. It was felt that there were only two options open, namely either rumble strips or a restriction on the speed limit to 20mph.

Discussion re need for signage at ~~car park~~ village amenity

Cllr Wildman showed members a mock-up of the sign requested last month. PCC had advised that it would cost £17.18 + VAT. Cllr Young advised other members that the ~~car park~~ village amenity had not been closed during this calendar year and needed to be closed to establish and retain ownership of the car park by this community council. To that end, it was agreed to change the date agreed last month to 15th December this year and annually thereafter. A new sign was to be purchased with the wording ‘This village amenity will be closed for a 24 hour period commencing 12 noon on 15th December annually’. Two of each signs to be purchased from PCC.

It was unanimously agreed to have these signs printed and Cllr Wildman would progress with PCC to get the four signs printed. Item to be listed on the December agenda.

Discussion re Dial a Ride Scheme

It had been previously agreed to contribute £125.00 to PACTO and the cheque was signed and handed to Cllr Wildman to forward on.

Discussion of problems with vehicles parking on the Milking Bank

Cllr Summons advised members that two new posts had been installed by PCC on the bank but already one had gone missing.

Discussion re Situation of Play Equipment

Cllr Wildman reminded members of correspondence received from Mrs K Thomas voicing concerns over lack of play equipment in the village. Cllr Wildman suggested that a response be sent suggesting that it would need the community to get together as it would be community facility and advising Mrs Thomas that if she could get support from other residents, then RCC would host a public meeting to discuss the way forward. Clerk to email Mrs Thomas advising her of these comments.

Discussion re Graveyard Matters

The clerk read out an email received from Mr Peter Blight voicing his concerns over the state of the hedge at the bottom of Front Street and what he felt was the need for a wall and gates. Councillors agreed that the area was in need of upkeep and advised that the graveyard was in the ownership of PCC and therefore were responsible for any remedial works. It was agreed that the clerk would forward on the complaint to PCC asking them to tidy up the hedge and around the gateway. Also to respond to Mr Blight advising him of the action taken.

Councillors were reminded of the Church Remembrance Service to be held at 10.30am on Sunday 13th and then the service at the village hall at 11.30am.

Cllr Wildman advised of St Non’s event to be held at the Picton Centre on 26th November 2011.

Cllr Wildman advised of a letter received from a concerned resident over vandalism. Cllr Wildman had advised the resident to contact the police on this matter.

Cllr Summons advised that a resident living in Back Land had cut down large branches from an oak tree which had been left lying on the ground.
